PURPOSE

Established in 1985, Jackson Christian Preschool (JCP) is a ministry of Jackson Memorial Baptist Church. We have served, many children, their families, and our community for decades. PERSONNEL

Each teacher and assistant are qualified for their position by means of formal education and/or experiences. LICENSURE

The Preschool qualifies with the State Department of Social Services for Religious Exemption from state licensure. Necessary documentation of facilities, insurance, health and safety, personnel qualifications and enrollment capacity has been submitted and is available for public review.

Registration

Current students and their siblings are allowed to pre-register in February for the upcoming school year. March 7 we will begin open registration, on a first-come, first-served basis.

At this time children three or four years old by September 30 (the same as Virginia's public-school requirement). All children enrolling in preschool **must be potty trained**.

Curriculum

Through intentional planning and meaningful experiences children will gain a deeper understand of themselves and the world around them. Our lessons align with standards set by the state of Virginia including but not limited to:

Social & Emotional: developing relationships with others, learning about themselves, and discovering their emotions & finding the words to express them

Approaches to Learning: discovering dispositions, attitudes, habits and styles that reflect the way they involve themselves in learning such as persistence, curiosity, creativity and problem-solving.

Language & Literacy: understanding the meaning and structure of words and sentences, use words to convey meaning, understand & use printed material through phonological & alphabetic, and print awareness, comprehension and early writing.

Mathematical Concepts: understanding the meaning of numbers & operations, measurement, patterns, shapes, spatial sense, data collection, and time & sequence

Scientific Knowledge & Exploration: testing their knowledge and understanding about the earth, living things, including their relationships and interdependencies through observation, questions and data collection & analysis

History: Understanding of the continuum of events occurring in successions – the past to the present and into the future

Geography: Understanding of directionality, position, and location, and knowledge of people, places and regions

Fine Arts: including music & movement, theater arts (dramatic play), and visual arts where children develop independence, self-esteem, and self-expression

Physical Development & Health: learning what it means to be healthy and why it is so important

Classes

We currently accommodate ages 3 and 4-years-old. Our learning environment allows us to provide individual attention children need to learn and grow cognitively, emotionally, and physically. Each teacher and assistant are responsive to the unique needs of each child and create an atmosphere that is both geared for success to build confidence as well as challenging, helping children to discover their potential. Preschool is located on the lower level, in the preschool wing of the church building.

Recess

Physical activity an important part of the school day. Studies have shown that recess is a vital part of a child's physical, emotional, and cognitive development. Our day includes 30 minutes where children run, jump, and play. We make every effort to go outside, however, if weather does not permit, we have a large area available inside

Parent – Teacher Communication

Parents are a valued part of a child's support system and we strongly encourage an open dialogue through-out the school year. Our goal is to come along side both our children and their families and learn and grow together. There is one parent teacher conference scheduled during the year, however we will make time for additional conferences as needed.

Immunizations

All enrolled children must be up-to-date on required immunizations for their age.

Field Trips

Should we be able to include fieldtrips next school year they will be coordinated with a unit of study. Sometimes, we will go off campus and other times we will have visitors that come to us. When we go off campus, we will travel in the church vehicles with drivers approved by the church's insurance company. We require high parent participation on these trips in order to have a good ratio of children to adults. Parents will be notified of all field trips. A permission form must be signed by all parents in order for a child to participate in a field trip off campus. According to Virginia law, all of our children must be in a child safety / booster seat in order to travel in church vehicles.
